I. Goals and Objectives of the Festival

1. To encourage students of clarinet and saxophone specialties to develop their stage experience;
2. To encourage students' musicality, aesthetic taste, to reveal and develop the professional skills of young talents in the art of performance;
3. To encourage educators to expand the repertoire of music schools;
4. To encourage educators of music schools to cooperate, to develop methodological knowledge, pedagogical practice and subject competence.

II. Rules of the Festival

1. Students of clarinet and saxophone from various educational institutions in Lithuania and abroad are invited to participate in the festival.
2. Festival participants categories and program:

CATEGORY	INSTRUMENTS	PROGRAM
I category	Clarinet	Each participant performs 2 (two) freely chosen pieces of different character. The program is performed by heart.
II category	Saxophone	
III category	Clarinets' ensembles*	Each ensemble performs 2 (two) freely chosen pieces of different character. The program is performed from scores.
IV category	Saxophones' ensemble*	
* The ensemble consists of at least 3 performers. The ensemble performs the pieces without the accompaniment of other instruments (e.g. piano, accordion, etc.). The age group of the ensemble is determined by the oldest member of the ensemble.		

3. Age groups of festival participants (applicable to each category):

B	13-14 years	Up to 7 minutes
C	15-16 years	Up to 10 minutes
D	17-19 years	Up to 15 minutes
